## Sunday, December 17, 2017: 6th Week of Advent: The Genealogy of Jesus Christ (28th Sunday after Pentecost)

Welcome: Spend some time checking in with the students. Attach flames to the appropriate candles on the Advent wreaths on the bulletin board in the foyer. The kids can take them home after today's class. Remind them to attach a flame on the white candle on Christmas.

Opening Prayer: "Our Father" – see poster board

Gospel: Luke 14:16-24 – Read Gospel in class

Lesson: 6th Week of Advent: The Genealogy of Jesus Christ

-Even though Jesus is God the Son, the second person in the Holy Trinity, He is also a man.

- -We can trace his family from Abraham all the way to Joseph and Mary
- -Listen to all the names in Matthew 1; how many names did you count?
- -Because Jesus became a man and became part of the human family, we can become part of God's family

#### Craft: Jesse Tree

- Materials: Christmas tree outline, Jesse tree ornament worksheet
- How To: Colour/decorate the ornaments on the worksheet, as well as the Christmas tree outline. Cut out the ornaments and paste onto the Christmas tree outline.

\*\*\*Because there are a lot of ornaments, the children can divide them among themselves rather that trying to fit all of them on their one tree.

End of Class: Hand out "Car Qs" to children, and "Cheat Sheet" to parents.

- 2. The Gospel of Matthew begins with the genealogy of Christ and starts with Abraham.
- 3. One could argue that the beginning of Jesus' family tree could actually begin with Adam, but God chose Abraham to be the "father of a multitude of nations," namely the nation of Israel and the Jewish faith.
